KU - KPS INTERNATIONAL TRAINING IN IRRIGATION DEVELOPMENT & MANAGEMENT

Kasetsart University, Kamphaeng Saen Campus (KU - KPS) with the supporting of Thailand International Cooperation Agency (TICA), Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand and Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation (MASHAV), Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Israel provided the international training in "training in IRRIGATION DEVELOPMENT & MANAGEMENT" to 24 participants from CLMV countries (Cambodia, Lao, Myanmar and Vietnam) and other Asian countries included Thailand during February 19 – March 2, 2018. The opening speech was given by Ambassador Mr. Gil Haskel, Deputy Director General, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Israel and Head of Mashav - Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation.
